- \_\_\_ **Gift Shop** – Organization and packing phone/online orders for shipping.
- \_\_\_ **Gardening** – Assist Gardener with planting and upkeep of the historic museum grounds.
- \_\_\_ **Collections** – Assist Supervisor of Collections with care, storage and record keeping or artifacts.
- \_\_\_ **Administration** – Miscellaneous office tasks, assembling mailings and preparing newsletters and event fliers for distribution.
